Open to: All Lifetime Lawyers

This Lifetime Lawyer is dedicated to supporting older and vulnerable people not just through their paid work. They freely give of their time to make a difference to the lives of older and vulnerable people through exceptional dedication, compassion, and unwavering advocacy. Whether it is by delivering free law clinics, working as a trustee, volunteering at memory cafes, putting on events, or simply helping people through befriending services or other activities/services. They are a strong advocate of CSR within their firm and also inspires others to get involved.

Requirements

Your submission will need to consist of 3 main parts:

Part 1 – Your covering statement (a maximum of 150 words)

This should state why you should win this award.

Part 2 – Your full submission (a maximum of 1000 words)

You will need to cover the following:

Your submission must tell the story about why you should win the *Outstanding Contribution in the Older and/or Vulnerable Community* award and must also cover the specific criteria below:

1. Describe the contribution you have made to the older and/or vulnerable community
2. Discuss how your contribution has had an impact on the community
3. Discuss how you intend to make further contribution in the future
4. Discuss what you have learned from serving others in the community and the impact it has had on you

Please provide one piece of supporting evidence in an appendix to your submission, clearly stating to which of the four points above your evidence relates.

Part 3 – Your Pearl of Wisdom (a sentence or short paragraph)

What one piece of advice would you share with the audience to help them in their work? This could be a technical insight, a tip, an observation, something that works well for you, or advice shared with you that has stuck with you.

NB: The best pearls of wisdom may be shared with the audience as we would like to give audience members something really useful to take away from the Twilight Awards.
